



5.3 Details of Access

- The village of Netheravon is easily accessible by road but buses are infrequent and taxis or rental cars are recommended.

9 Insurance Requirements

All Non-EU competitors, judges and officials participating in this event will be covered by BPA temporary membership where required. European Union (EU) participants who are current members of their own country's parachuting governing organisations, are FAI licenced, have a minimum of 100 descents and hold current third party liability insurance cover of a minimum of £1,300,00 will not require BPA temporary membership.

All UK parachutists must also have either a Declaration of Fitness to Parachute/Doctor's Certificate or appropriate Medical Certificate. In accordance with the BPA Operations Manual a parachutist from a foreign country may parachute at a BPA PTO if he/she fulfils the medical requirements of the parachutist's own country.

10 Facilities

- 2 Hangars; one for the 3 aircraft and one for the training facility

11 Aircraft

The Dropzone operates 3 Cessna Caravans all fitted for skydiving operations with in-flight doors, restraints and jump step.



Exit speed will typically be no greater than 70kts.

Jump capacity is typically 90 jumps per hour subject to the number of wingsuit passes required.

12 Pre-event Training

The Dropzone will be open for practice jumps from 12:00hrs on Friday 22nd May right through until Monday afternoon of the 25th May. During this time normal jump ticket prices will apply: £21 for max altitude. All 3 aircraft are available.

It would be helpful for the dropzone to know in advance of any competitors planning to arrive early with the intention of training to ensure the other activities on the dropzone do not impede training.

13 Registration / Entry Fees

13.1 Fees

Each nation may register up to 12 competitors, one Head of Delegation and one TM/Coach. All participants are responsible for their own accommodation, travel and transportation costs.

13.2 Payment of Registration Fees

The delegations can use the following payment methods.

- a) Credit Card (VISA, Master Card, American Express) payments will be surcharged an extra 3% fee.
- b) If using a wire transfer, the whole amount as per the section on Entry Fees must reach the organiser's account.

All Bank charges must be paid by the sender. Payment must be made in GB Pounds Bank details are published at the website www.netheravon.com/wswc2015

In case the conditions of a) or b) are not fully fulfilled by the entry deadline, the remaining money must be paid in cash in GBP before any jumps are made.

13.3 Registration Forms

The registration form is attached and can be used for Provisional or Final entry or both. The Registration Form is for each country/delegation and can also be obtained at www.netheravon.com/wswc2015 and on the FAI website. The form may be printed and submitted by mail, or saved and emailed to apasecretary@netheravon.com.

13.4 Entry Dates

Provisional Entry Date (60 days prior)

Preliminary registration must be received by 25 March 2015.

Official Entry Date (30 days prior)

Final registration with all payments must reach the organiser by **25 April 2015**. Late registration (after 25 April 2015) may be accepted if capacity allows; however, a 10% late fee (£48 for competitors/£26 for non-competitors) will be charged.

14 FAI Sporting Licences

A valid FAI Sporting Licence for 2015 is required and must be obtained through the Competitor's NAC. All competitors must be registered by their NAC in the FAI Sporting Licence Database (http://www.fai.org/about-fai/fai-sporting-licences) before submitting the Official Entry Form to the Organiser.

15 Safety Information & Required Equipment

- All participants are required to wear equipment which is in compliance with the Sporting Code Section 5 rules and the 2015 WS Performance Flying Rules.
- All parachute operations will be conducted under the BPA Operations Manual and APA Standard Operating Procedures.
- Automatic Activation Devices (AADs) are mandatory at Netheravon. Helmets are also mandatory under the BPA Operations Manual rules.
- Safety vehicles will be on standby to respond to any incident.

16 Rules

Up to 12 competitors per nation may compete in the World Cup. The 2015 Wingsuit Performance Flying competition rules include WS-specific safety requirements which competitors must observe. These rules are effective March 1st and will be published on the FAI/IPC website: http://www.fai.org/ipc-documents.

17 National Anthem and Flags

Delegations are encouraged to bring their national dress and clothing along. Official Team uniforms/dress/formal wear are encouraged.

Delegations must bring their country's national flag (size 1m x 1.5m) and the national anthem (short version less than one minute) via MP3 audio file, or may send them in advance to apasecretary@netheravon.com or together with the Final Entry Form.

The Organiser/Host can provide a flag at nominal cost if the country cannot provide one. Please request this via the email address above.

18 Medical Care

The APA has a number of First Aid qualified staff who will be on-site during the event. In addition, full ambulance and medical services are available with 999 emergency services. Med-evac helicopter and ambulance services are readily available and a major trauma centre hospital exists in Salisbury (16 miles from the Dropzone).
