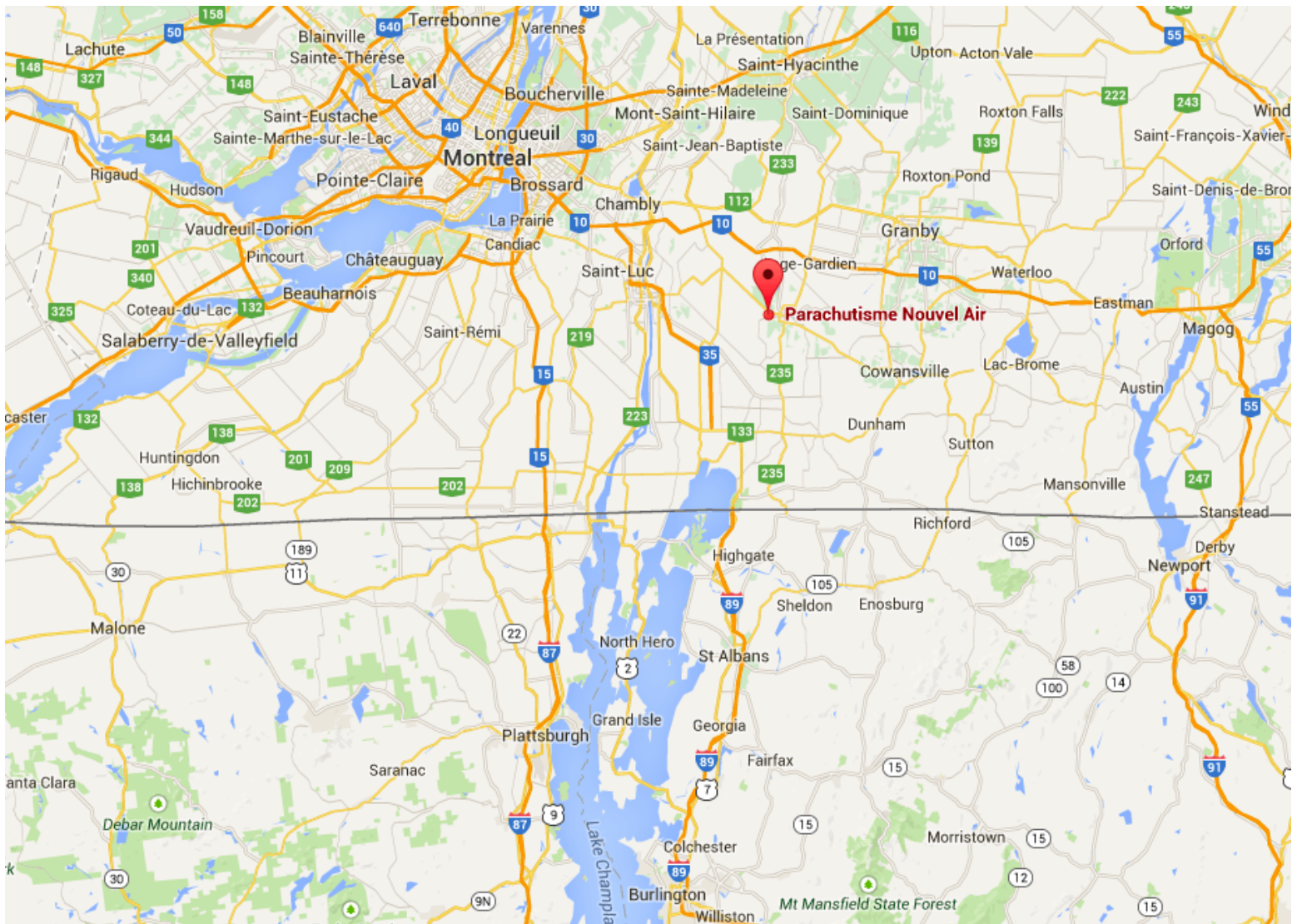

- Quick-release weight-belt (if applicable)

14. Visas

Visitors travelling to Canada must:

- have a valid travel document, such as a passport, AND NECESSARY TRAVEL DOCUMENTS, WHERE APPLICABLE (SEE LIST FOR NECESSARY VISA APPLICATIONS) INCLUDING A RETURN FLIGHT TICKET TO YOUR HOME COUNTRY.

Competitors in need of a visa to travel to Canada must apply through Citizenship and Immigration Canada. An estimate 3-4 weeks lead-time is required. Competitors will be provided a sponsored letter from the NAC and Organizing Committee.

18. Insurance

Each must have medical insurance valid in Canada covering repatriation costs and Third Party insurance valid in Canada. Proof of third party liability insurance valid in Canada must be given to the Organizer upon arrival at the event. If there are any discrepancies or the competitor is unable to provide this, they can affiliate with CSPA (cost \$89) onsite and have \$3M third party liability coverage while parachuting in Canada. Event liability insurance covering Officials and Judges will be arranged by the Organizer.

19. Other Matters

- Delegation are encouraged to bring their national dress and clothing along. National anthems should be sent with Final Registration form on an mp3 audio file to martin@nouvelair.ca
- Delegation have to bring their own national flag (approximately 150 cm X 100 cm) to be raised during awards ceremony.
