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2. VENUE and ACCESS DETAILS:

Dubai, United Arab Emirates (UAE): The World Cup competition site is located at Skydive Dubai Desert Campus, about 45 km south of Dubai City Centre. It is near to the village of Margham. Coordinates: 24°53'17"N 55°32'46"E, 166 m above MSL.

2.1 Venue: Skydive Dubai Desert Campus Dropzone, is off Al Ain-Dubai Rd (E 66), just before the road sign for Margham (exit 47). Follow the road under the bridge and make a right turn at the roundabout from where the road will bring you to the parking lot.

2.2 Airports:

a) Dubai International Airport (DXB) - 55 km/40 minutes by car from competition site is the recommended airport entry point to Dubai.

Shuttle service from the airport to the hotel will be provided on official arrival days at three scheduled departure times each day, specified in Bulletin - 2.

b) Al Maktoum International (DWC) – 78km: appr. 1hr drive by car from competition site. No shuttle service provided.

c) International airports for entry to Dubai in vicinity of venue in an appr. 2 hour driving distance are in **Abu Dhabi** or **Sharjah**. No shuttle provided.

d) All locations provide rental car services. DBX metro service to Dubai City locations, not to venue.

3. DISCIPLINES/RULES:

Canopy Piloting Competition Rules 2017, SC GS 2017, SC5 2017

- Distance – 3 rounds, 2 Drag Distance - 50m, 1 Max Distance
- Carved Speed - 3 rounds, left hand carve.
- Accuracy – 3 rounds (Direction will be at the discretion of the Chief Judge since the swoop pond supports both directions).

- Official arrival day November 25, 2017, start of FCE
- Official departure day December 02, 2017, end of FCE
- Opening Ceremony, November 27, 2017 in the evening (TBA)
- Closing Ceremony, December 01, 2017 (TBA)
- Competition starts, November 28, 2017
- Competition ends, December 01, 2017
- Official departure day, end of FCE 02 December 2017

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5. PERSONAL REQUIREMENTS:

5.1 As stated in the SC 5 and the Competition Rules Canopy Piloting. This includes in particular a current FAI Sporting License, being electronically documented in the FAI data base.

National regulations do not require that life-saving equipment must be worn in the vicinity of water while skydiving. It is recommended to wear flotation devices in cases where inability to swim or to stay afloat in waters of depth of appr.1.2 m in the pond is prevalent.

An AAD is not, but a hard shell head protection according to CP Competition Rules is mandatory. Also, competitors wearing additional weight-systems must feature a quick release system (cutaway) for additional weight (lead belt) as required in CP CR 4.1.5.

6. INSURANCES / RESPONSIBILITIES:

Personal health insurance and repatriation coverage are the responsibility of each participant and is highly advisable.

Liability insurance coverage to third parties for the event is provided by the organizer. This does not apply for any damage caused by a participant in freefall or under

canopy.

Any such damage is the responsibility of the parachutist. Third party liability insurance for the parachute and/or participant is highly advisable.

Any damage to hotel rooms etc. is the responsibility of the persons involved.

Personal items and equipment are the responsibility of each participant.

7. VISA REQUIREMENTS:

Visitors travelling to Dubai must:

- Have a valid travel document, such as a passport valid for 6 months from day of entry.
- Be in good health

Competitors will be provided with a support letter for visa application if requested from the NAC and the Organizing Committee.

8. AWARDS / TROPHIES / PRIZES:

Medals and Trophies will be awarded in all disciplines/events for the first three placings according to the Competition Rules for each discipline/event, which will be provided by the organizer, conforming with the FAI specifications in the IPC rules.

Money prize awards are:

USD \$10,000 for 1st Place Overall

USD \$7,000 for 2nd Place Overall

USD \$ 5,000 for 3rd Place Overall

Individual categories prize money has not been acknowledged by the sponsor up to date, as initially announced.

BTKS Scoring System as stated in the bid document.

14. AIRCRAFT:

Twin Otter: Left door Exit

Exit Speed: 80 kts (+ / - 5 kts)

Lift Capacity: 20 jumpers, 4-5 loads/hour

Cessna Caravan: Left door exit

Exit speed: 80 kts (+ / - 5 kts)

Lift Capacity: 15 jumpers, 4 loads/hour

Pilatus Porter PC-6: Right door exit

Exit speed: 70 kts (+/- 5 kts)

Lift capacity: 9 jumpers

15. WEATHER:

Average daytime temperature: 28.5° (high) and 17.5° (low) centigrade during the day with cooler nights.

Wind: Average wind speed is 3-5 m/s (6-10 knots). Main directions: W/NW

Sunrise: 6:53 am Sunset: 5:35 pm.

16. PRE COMPETITION TRAINING / OPP:

The Drop zone is an active training center (open daily during event period)

One official Training jump, prior to the competition jumps, will be granted according to the Competition Rules during the OPP and is included in the Entry Fee.

Costs for additional training Jumps at "SD Desert Campus" will be 65 AED per ticket (18.00 USD) – 5000ft (1500m)

17. PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEM / ON-SITE COMMUNICATIONS:

17.1 A Public address system is already in place with proven functionality for 150+ skydivers events.

17.2 A big screen is to be set up.

17.3 Ground radios provided for communication between event Officials, Manifest and Support Staff.

17.4 Wi-Fi available on the drop zone.

18. MEDIA PLAN:

For duration of the event, a press center will be available. Good relationships have been created with national and regional press during National Record events and National Competitions. Cooperation with IPC media liaison officer is granted and appreciated

19. MEDICAL FACILITIES / IMMEDIATE MEDICAL CARE:

Adequate medical services according to SC 5, paragraph 4.5.3 (3), will be provided at the drop zone of "SD Desert Campus" during the event, including the OPP. There will be a team of minimum two (2) paramedics from the Dubai Ambulance Service, equipped and ready to respond to any emergency on site. Medevac helicopter will be on standby for the duration of the event, being at the drop zone in less than 20 minutes.

22.1 National Delegation members according to CP CR 2017; 3.2 and SC 5; 4.4.2.

Attention: IPC Sanction Fee of € 90,00 per person is NOT included.

The € 90,00 must be added to the amount of the Entree Fee stated in US-Dollars together with the final registration:

- One Head of Delegation: USD 750,00 + Sanction fee
- One Team Manager: USD 750,00 + Sanction Fee
- One Team Coach: USD 750,00 + Sanction Fee
- Up to 12 competitors: USD 850,00 per competitor + Sanction fee per competitor.

22.2 **Accompanying** Delegation persons **not subject to IPC-Sanction Fee payment** - limited to **two (2) per delegation**: USD 1000.00 per person.

- one accredited medical: USD 1500.00.
- one accredited media person: USD 1500.00.

Entry fee includes accommodation (dbl. occupancy), meals as in § 9.2, starting from dinner on the official arrival day to breakfast on official departure day, social events. Transport from/to International Airport as specified in Bulletin-2, local transportation from/ to hotel and venue site, starting on OPP day 2 and all jumps according to CR 2017, i.e. one training jump and re-jumps included.

23. PAYMENT DETAILS:

Bank transfer is the preferred method of payment. Deadline for final pay fees will be:

September 26, 2017 (60 days prior to event, i.e. September 26, 2017).

Payments for Entry fee and Sanction Fee can be combined into **one** currency, either in USD or in EUR, at the official interbank exchange rate of the day of the bank-order. All bank charges for money exchange and bank money transfer must be paid by the sender.

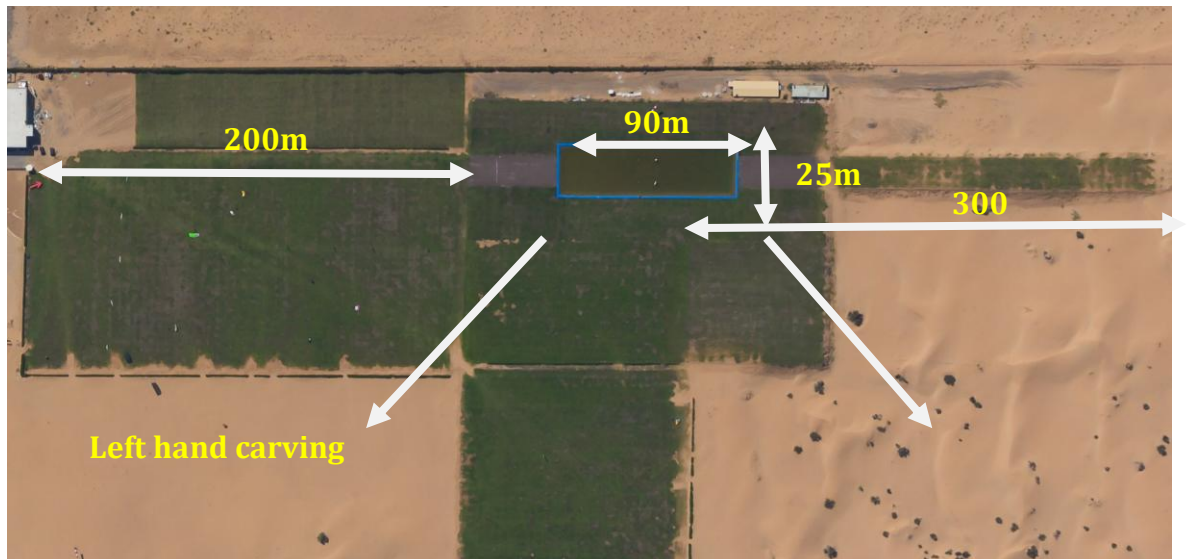
