#### 1. General

The **FAI World Aerobatic Championships** (WAC) 2011 is organized by the Italian National Aeroclub (AeCI) in co-operation with the Aeroclub Foligno.

#### 1.1 Venue

The 26th FAI WAC 2011 will be held at the civilian airfield Foligno (LIAF). Foligno is a city located along Central Italian region of Umbria. Basically, this city is known for its manufacturing industry that produces paper, textiles, machinery and other transport and machinery items. It is among the rare cities in Umbria which is built across the plain and it rises until the banks of the River Topino. Lot of tourists come to this place due to the numerous historical attractions offered by this city. There are lovely museums, cathedrals and churches including special events and festivals that are held in this city every year.

Foligno can be reached from across different towns and cities located closer to this place including Assisi, Bevagna, Montefalco and Trevi by driving. The Foligno railway station is at a distance of 9 kms from Bevagna and taxis are easily available from this location, including car rental services and buses that run on the weekdays. If you are coming from North Italy, then you can reach this place through Florence and Perugia by train. The nearest international airports are S. Egidio Airport in Perugia, Fiumicino and Ciampino Airports in Rome and Falconara Airport in Ancona, which are respectively about 30 kms, 190 kms, 170 Kms and 120 kms from Foligno airfield.

The airfield in Foligno has one concrete runway and one grass runway available.



2.1 Aerobatic box will be aligned with the active runway and set to the South West approximately abeam of runway 35 threshold as shown in Figure 1.

# 5. Refund Policy

#### **5.1 Event Cancellation Policy**

If the organising Body cancels WAC before the 30<sup>th</sup> June 2011, entry fees will be refunded in full. In circumstances where the event is cancelled after the 30<sup>th</sup> June 2011, all unspent WAC funds will be used to repay as much of the entry fees as possible, with priority given to participants who paid their entry fees earliest. The Organising Body shall not be liable for any failure to perform its obligations where such failure is as a result of Acts of God (including fire, flood, earthquake, storm, hurricane or other natural disaster), war, invasion, acts of foreign enemies, terrorist activities, labour dispute or strike. All entry fee refunds will be made by the Organising Body. Neither the Organising Body nor the Officiating Body will be responsible for repayment of any other consequential losses (airline tickets, travel costs, etc) incurred by participants as a result of cancellation of WAC.

#### **5.2 Refund Policy**

If an entered pilot or official has to withdraw, his/her NAC may substitute another pilot or official with no financial penalty. If a participant wishes to cancel their entry for WAC 2011 (all fee paying participants), the NAC must contact the Organising Body in writing to withdraw the participant. The date of withdrawal will be noted by the Organising Body and will set the proportion of the fee to be refunded by the Organising Body thus:

Date Cancellation received by Organising Body	Proportion of Fee to be Refunded
On or before 31 <sup>st</sup> May	100%
1 <sup>st</sup> June – 15 <sup>th</sup> July	50%
16 <sup>th</sup> July – 15 <sup>th</sup> August	30%
15 <sup>th</sup> August onwards	0%

- **5.4** If a competitor is disqualified from the event by the International Jury or Chief Judge, none of the entry fee will be refunded.



# 6. Training Sites

- **6.1** Some airfields in the vicinity of Foligno and Foligno airfield are prepared to host training camps ahead of WAC 2011.
- **6.2** Priority will be given to teams travelling a long distance to the contest, then to other teams based on who asks for assistance first.
- **6.3** Training Sites are planning to host teams between the 16<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>th</sup> August 2011. Contact Organising Body for more assistance with training sites: info@wac2011.it

- **7.1** Hangars are available onsite, but the space available will be limited. Priority will be given to those whose entry fee payment is confirmed by 31<sup>st</sup> May 2011. Pilots should in any case bring equipment needed to tie down on grass and cover their aircraft.
