C 1. COUNTRY FLAGS AND NATIONAL ANTHEMS

C 2. PRELIMINARY ENTRY FORM

A Preliminary Entry Form has been attached to this bulletin. Please complete the form, print it out as PDF and send it by e-mail to entry@wpfc2013.de by **1st May 2013** at the latest.

C 3. OFFICIAL WEBSITE

The official website for the 21st World Precision Flying Championships has been available since the beginning of this year. All information will be published on this site. We recommend visiting www.wpfc2013.de regularly to keep up-to-date with the latest news and information.

C 4. PHOTOS

On the Official Entry Form we will ask all participants to send us a digital photo, preferably in JPG format, to be published in all official documents and on our website. You are kindly requested to give us the permission to use your photo.

C 5. VISA

If you need assistance in getting the necessary visa for Germany, please contact us as soon as possible. Please mark it accordingly on the Preliminary Entry Form or send an e-mail to info@wpfc2013.de.

C 6. LICENCES

All pilots holding a licence issued by a non-EASA country need to validate their licences in Germany. We are in contact with our national aviation authorities (LBA) to make acceptance as smooth as possible. If you require licence validation, please mark it accordingly on the Preliminary Entry Form. We will provide an update on the applicable requirements and further information in one of the next bulletins.

C 7. GNSS LOGGERS

According to the FAI Rules and Regulations Precision Flying -2013 Edition- the use of Flight Data Recording Equipment is mandatory. Only Equipment approved by GAC may be used. The current list of approved GNSS flight recorders is available on the FAI webpage. You will be asked to indicate the logger type on the Official Entry Form. Please make sure you have the software and hardware to download the GAC file available. If you have any questions concerning the use of loggers, please feel free to contact us.



C 8. ANR PRESENTATION

Together with GAC's ANR subcommittee, we intend to present the new FAI AIR NAVIGATION RACE competition. You are kindly invited to join the presentation and to try out a race track prepared by the ANR development team during the training week. We will provide you with more information about the ANR in the next bulletin.
