2. DISCIPLINES AND ROUNDS IN THE COMPETITION

NOTE:

- All competitors will be required to perform both disciplines at each stage of the competition.
- The crews, having highest sum of points (both disciplines added up) in qualification heat, quarter and semifinal will be qualified for the further competition.

3. REGISTRATION & PERSONAL REQUIREMENTS

Both crew members must be in the possession of a valid FAI Sporting License. Pilots must be in the possession of a valid Pilots License with Medical Certificate.

All selected competitors MUST register (or withdraw) before August 15, 2015. Please see the detailed process in General Bulletin #1, Section 5.3 – Registration to the World Air Games for more details.

For every helicopter must be produced to the Organizer a valid “Certificate of Airworthiness” or equivalent document and a Certificate of Registration issued by an appropriate authority.

The required equipment for both disciplines, specially described in the event rules and their annexes, will be provided by the Organizer.

4. AIMS

- ✓ To determine “World Air Games Helicopter Champion”
- ✓ To create a sense of community between different air sports disciplines
- ✓ To promote public participation in air sport by attracting new participants to helicopter sport
- ✓ To exchange ideas and strengthen friendly relations between participants of the FAI World Air Games Dubai 2015.

5. AWARDS

The crew, having the highest number of points in the final heat, will be awarded the title “World Air Games Helicopter Champion”. Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals and Trophies will be awarded for the first three placed crews.

The number and types of available helicopters will be decided at later stage according to the final list of invited crews.

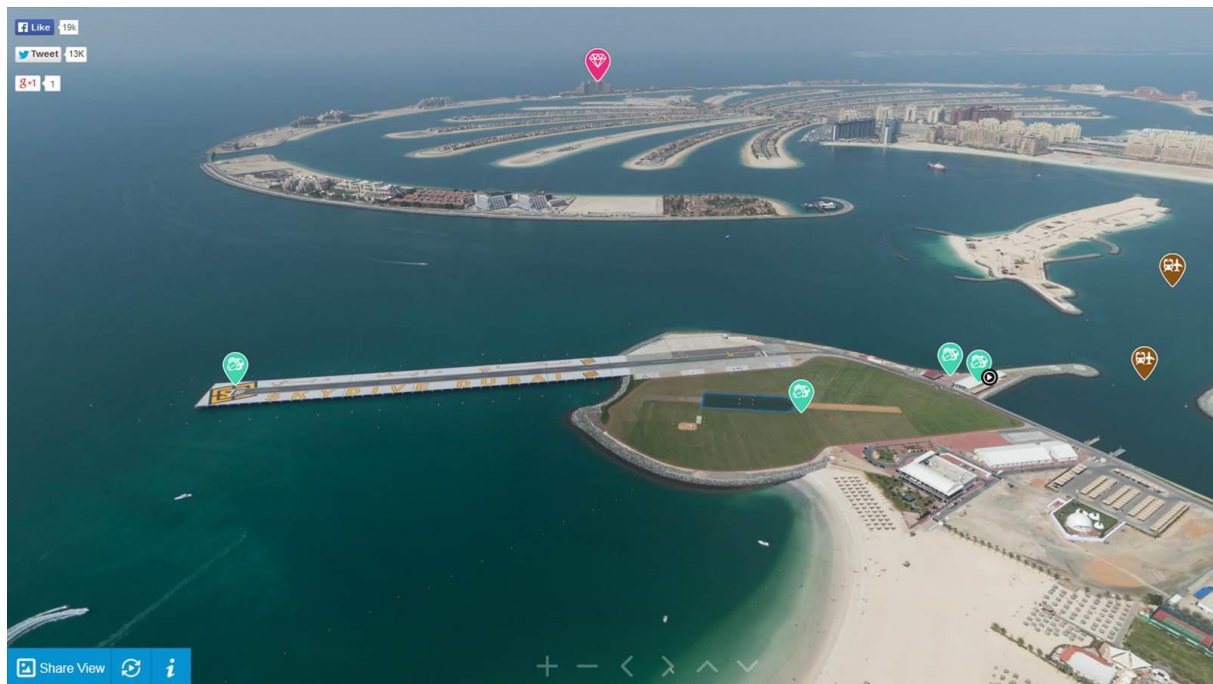

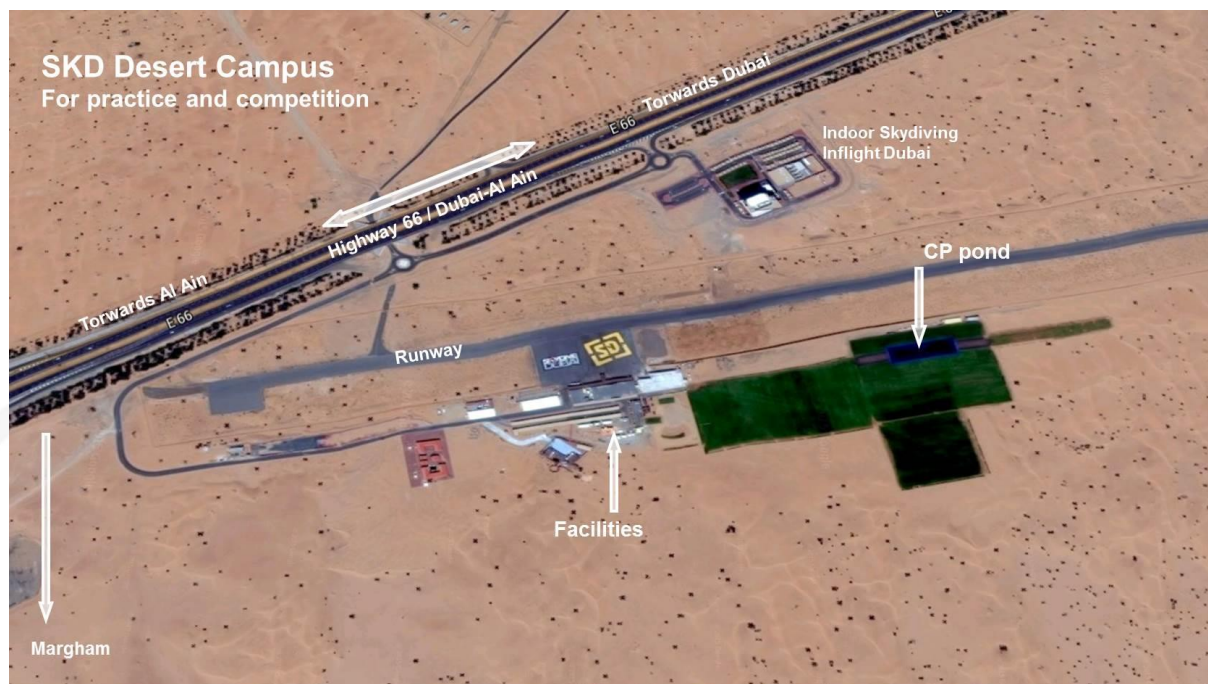
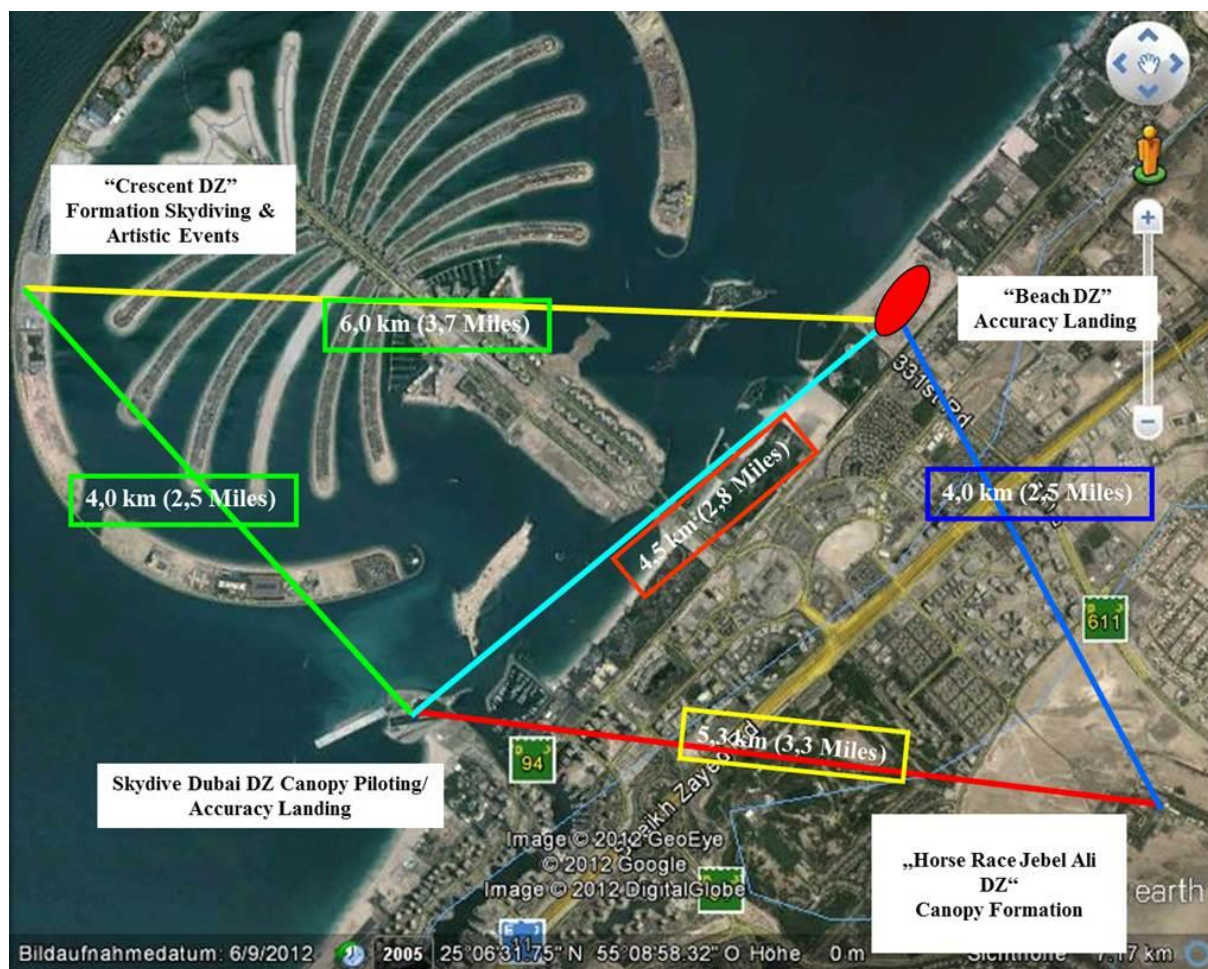
For training flights, minor fee can be asked to cover fueling costs. To be communicated at a later stage.
