# 3. DEADLINES AND TIMELINE FOR REGISTRATION

August 27, 2015: Registration deadline for selected pilots.

August 28, 2015: Registration status / list published and invitations issued to pilots from the

reserve list

September 14, 2015: Final Registration deadline for reserve list pilots.

September 15, 2015: Final Registration status / list published.

Replacement pilots for any drop-out from the Final Registration list may be accepted from the reserve list up to the start of the event.

# 5. TRAVELING

All personal travel arrangements and costs must be taken by the competitors. All in-country costs will be covered by the organizer but travelling costs will NOT be covered. See General Bulletin #1, Section 7, 8 and 9.

# 6. ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation will be assigned to the pilot once his registration has been confirmed and his planned arrival and departure dates in Dubai are known from the organizer.

Generally, all ballooning and airship competitors and officials are planned to stay at the same hotel, if possible. This hotel will also host the competition center and briefing room.

A reserved parking for all balloon and official vehicles will be marked outside the hotel. The parking will normally be guarded 24h a day.

# 7. PARTICIPANTS

The complete airship team will consist of pilot + 3 crew members. All 4 members of the team are considered participants.

As per SC S1 An3 6, the official competitors list, compiled from the roll call of the entrants taken at the general briefing, shall be published as soon as practicable after the general briefing but before the first task briefing.

# 8. EQUIPMENT

# 8.1. Shipping you equipment to Dubai

The host organizer is delighted to offer to all concerned competitors the shipment of their equipment from a "country specified warehouse" to the competition venue. The official and exclusive logistics provider of the FAI World Air Games Dubai 2015 is DHL Trade Fairs & Events.

Competitors will have to pay the shipping costs from the home place of their equipment to the country specified warehouse. Shipment from the country specified warehouse to Dubai is covered by the organizer.

The country specified warehouse will be chosen after collecting all competitors' information and requirements. Competitors will be informed as well in due time and DHL Trade Fairs & Events will target country specified warehouse in order to make as cheap as possible for all competitors the shipment from home place of the equipment to the country specified warehouse.

Due to this short timeline, it is very important that all competitors contact immediately DHL Trade Fairs & Events to proceed. FAI provided them the list of selected competitors in order to monitor the process quickly. You may receive incoming call or email from them to speed up the process.

Competitors are free to choose their own logistics provider (or drive) to bring their equipment to the country specified warehouse. However, note that doing the whole shipment with the same provider will ease all administrative matters especially custom clearance. DHL Trade Fairs & Events is offering to cover this topic for you.

All selected competitors for Ballooning competition shall follow the below procedure:

- 1. Connect to the <a href="DHL dedicated portal for the World Air Games">DHL dedicated portal for the World Air Games</a>.
- 2. Read the **Shipping Guidelines** (top right on the portal).
- 3. Prepare all documents, questions and information for DHL Trade Fairs & Events.
- 4. Contact directly DHL Trade Fairs & Events and organize the shipment of your equipment.

## 8.2. Advertisement

Due to very strict rules on advertising in the UAE (See General Bulletin - Section 16 – <u>Rules on advertisement in UAE</u>), picture of the airship you expect to fly in Dubai during the World Air Games must be sent for approval if you have any doubt. This picture will be forwarded to the organizing committee. In case of any issue you will be personally informed.

# 9. LOCAL TRANSPORTATION / RENTAL CAR

See General Bulletin <u>Section 7 – Entry fee and costs</u>. "Local transport" means free shuttle services available from all hotels to competition venues at regular hours.

Of course on a competition related aspect, for the airship event, the organizer is happy to provide one car per crew, capable to pull the trailer with the hot air airship equipment and crew. You will need to specify the tow ball size you require for your trailer hitch on the registration form. Rental of additional cars must be arranged by the competitor.

Third party balloon insurance is compulsory. Passenger insurance is compulsory if the pilot plans to fly with a navigator or one of his crew members. Each pilot will have to provide proof of insurance for flying in Dubai at registration.

Competitors will be expected to pay for the propane for all training flights and cover the additional cost of the rental for the vehicle outside the official competition time.
