

After over a century of steady growth, FAI is now an organisation of more than 100 member countries, forming a strong network linking all those who participate in air sports worldwide.



## President's Foreword



2015 was a milestone year for our Federation. The FAI World Air Games Dubai 2015, organised by our friends from the Emirates Aerosports Federation in December, was a resounding success. They will mark the history of FAI and will stay in our memories as a true celebration of air sports.

These were the **record Games**: 951 athletes competed in 40 medal events of 11 air sports at no less than six different venues in the sunny and friendly city of Dubai. From the small model aircraft to the imposing airships, the range of competitions was such that the spectators could discover and enjoy the full extent of air sports – without mentioning the impressive air shows and demonstration flights which also entertained the crowds.

I cannot recount here all the **fond memories** that I have of the event, for they are too many. However I will mention two that particularly stand out for me: the impressive opening ceremony in the presence of all the athletes and officials. And as a balloon pilot, I will always remember the extraordinary vision of the hot air balloons flying over the skyscrapers of the city. What a beautiful spectacle, and what a unique opportunity to share our passion with the whole population of Dubai!

I note that we have always kept in mind **FAI's mission** to promote air sports internationally. The efforts to reach out to the world that we put in, together with the organiser, in terms of competition format and communication, paid back. The media and public response was beyond expectations and shows that we must continue in this direction to get the promotion and attention for our events that they deserve.

Aside from the competitions, I was especially delighted by the **universal dimension of the event**. These Games were for everyone, uniting cultures, nationalities and backgrounds. They built bridges between the athletes of the different sports, and created a real sense of air sports community which can only develop a positive dynamic for the future.

All in all, I am proud of what we achieved with the Games. Since the competition was awarded to the Emirates Aerosports Federation in 2014, the whole **FAI community got into action to collaborate closely with the Organising Committee**. I want to salute the work accomplished by the Host, the Officials, the Commissions, the Members, the Head Office and all the volunteers who spent a tremendous amount of energy and time to make the competition happen. The challenges were great, as was the complexity in terms of logistics, but together we pulled it off. Thank you for your hard work.

I am also grateful to our hosts for their **hospitality and generosity**. The Organising Committee, under the leadership of FAI World Air Games President H.E. Saeed Mohammed Harib, Vice President H.E. Nasser Hmouda Al Neyady and Director H.E. Yousif Hassan Al Hammadi, made sure that everything took place in the best possible conditions.

With the success of the Dubai event, we can now look optimistically at the future of the FAI World Air Games, our flagship event. I already look forward to the next edition!

The 2015 competition scene, while occupied by the FAI World Air Games at the end of the year, also featured **710 Championships and regional competitions**. Three events were selected and supported by our sponsor **Breitling**, with whom we continued our collaboration: the 59th Coupe Aéronautique Gordon Bennett in Pau, France; the 28th FAI World Aerobatic Championships in Châteauroux, also France; and the 6th FAI World Sailplane Grand Prix Championship in Varese, Italy. I congratulate the organisers on turning their competitions into great popular events, on location and in the media.

Our partnership with **Red Bull Air Race**, which includes providing a Safety Delegate, the approval of the sporting rules and the production of medals for the winners by FAI, carried on successfully. We are delighted to be linked to such a captivating event which offers flying aces the chance to measure up to each other in thrilling competitions followed by millions of fans.

Exceptional skills are not only in evidence at competitions, but also during **record** flights. I find the incredible performances such as that of the Solar Impulse team, but also the less known achievements, inspiring and moving. Along with ratifying the 2015 records, we celebrated all year long the most striking and interesting performances drawn from our record archives.

The **2015 FAI Awards Ceremony** at the 109th FAI General Conference in Rotterdam, The Netherlands, saw the most active contributors to air sports celebrated. I was delighted to present our prestigious medals and diplomas to such esteemed members of our community. The FAI Gold Air Medal was awarded to Hans Akerstedt from Sweden, who was rewarded for his outstanding role in the progress of

aeronautics through his involvement and dedication to Ballooning. Alan Eustace received the Breitling Milestone Trophy for his breath-taking parachuting record, and fellow American Jarett Martin, the only wheelchair bound skydiver to have participated in an FAI World Championship, received the Breitling Youngster Award.


At the General Conference the **“FAI 2020” concept** was presented. The FAI World Air Games Dubai 2015 was the biggest multi-air sports competition ever organised.

From 1 to 12 December, 951 athletes from 52 countries competed for the much sought-after title of FAI World Air Games Champion. Eleven sports were in the competition programme: Aerobatics, Aeromodelling, Aerostats, Amateur-Built Aircraft, General Aviation, Gliding, Microlights, Paramotors, Parachuting, Paragliding and Rotorcraft. Never before were so many athletes from so many air sports given a stage to display their talents.

The Symposium on Medical Challenges in Extreme Air Sports and in Aviation, a side-event at the Games, attracted world-leading health and aviation experts on 4 and 5 December.

The Emirates Aerosports Federation, since being awarded the Games in June 2014, put great effort into making this event an unforgettable success, in close collaboration with FAI and its community of volunteers.

## CELEBRATION OF AIR SPORTS

Great care was given to the format of the competitions. The objective was to present all the sports at their best, in a way that would equally satisfy the athletes and the spectators, while ensuring they be adapted to the special flying conditions of the desert and over water. The Glider Match Racing event was created especially for the Games. Staying in view of the public located at the venue, identical gliders competed against each other in an exciting one-to-one regatta-style competition.

## AIR SPORTS IN THE CITY

Another particular feature of these Games, beyond their exceptionally large scale, is that they brought air sports to the people, as all the six venues were only a short distance from Dubai and its over two million inhabitants.

The main competition venue was Skydive Dubai Palm Jumeirah. Its location on a strip of land reclaimed from the sea at the edge of the city allowed the various activities of the Games to be visible to anyone living or working in the high-rise buildings of the area. Another field of play was the ice rink of the Dubai Mall, where the Indoor Aeromodelling event took place. Its wide open space at the heart of what is one of the world's busiest shopping centres gave the opportunity to the many passers-by to discover and enjoy the skilled manoeuvres of the model aircraft flying to the sound of music.

## A GLOBAL IMPACT AND A LASTING LEGACY

Sharing the host's concern to make the Games a global event, the Federation participated in ensuring international coverage, whether it be on TV, press or social media. The positive response to the communication efforts proved once again the great potential for air sports.

The success of the Games in Dubai and their worldwide impact were also crucial for the Federation in the long-term. Building upon this success, FAI can now look to the future of the FAI World Air Games optimistically, and focus on attracting the attention of bidders for the next edition of the competition.

The event year 2015, which culminated with the FAI World Air Games in December, has been bustling with activity for all air sports. In total, 69 Championships and 641 Category 2 competitions registered in the FAI Events Calendar have taken place all around the globe.

Several disciplines made their debut on the world competition scene, such as Indoor Skydiving, Wingsuit Performance Flying and Speed Skydiving.

## HIGHLIGHT EVENTS

FAI brought additional resources, including worldwide TV production and distribution, to three selected events to ensure their international media coverage. These competitions were also granted full support and branding by FAI's sponsor Breitling.

### 28th FAI World Aerobatic Championships

The 28th FAI World Aerobatic Championships were held from 20 to 29 August in the French city of Châteauroux. Playing at home, France topped almost all the rankings: general and male (Alexandre Orłowski), female (Aude Lemordant), and national team. The gold medal for Final Freestyle was the only one to slip from their grasp. That went to Rob Holland from USA, who thus became the first pilot in the history of the Championships to win this programme three times in a row (2011, 2013, 2015).

The competition proved to be a great popular success all week long. The public attendance culminated on the last day with some 60,000 visitors present at the airfield.

### 59th Coupe Aéronautique Gordon Bennett

Seventeen gas balloons from eight nations competed in the 59th Coupe Aéronautique Gordon Bennett long-distance race. About 5,000 spectators supported the teams at the launch site in Pau, South-West France, on the evening of 28 August. Emotions were at their highest when the world's best gas balloon pilots lifted off to the sound of their national anthems. After an excitingly tight finale on the fourth night, Kurt Frieden and Pascal Witprächtiger from Switzerland won the competition by landing the furthest away, near Jaczno, Poland, an impressive 2,080.80 km from the departure point.

### 6th FAI World Sailplane Grand Prix Championship



Maximilian Seis from France was the surprise winner of the 6th FAI World Sailplane Grand Prix Championship which took place in Varese, Italy, from 5 to 12 September. At the age of 22, although the youngest and one of the least experienced pilots, he proved that talent and motivation are two of the most important factors in winning such a competition. Seis won two of the races, was 4th in two, and placed 6th on the other race day, thus earning points on each day and flying very consistently.

Drawing up rules, controlling and ratifying aeronautical and astronautical records represent important aspects of FAI activities. Since the first record-setting flights were recorded in 1906, more than 16,000 world records have been ratified by FAI to date. The list of record-holders includes prestigious personalities such as Charles Lindbergh, Yuri Gagarin, Valentina Tereshkova, Jacqueline Cochran, Steve Fossett and Bertrand Piccard.

### GAS BALLOONS: 12,000 TO 16,000 M<sup>3</sup>

- Distance
- Duration

Having taken off from Saga, Japan, on 25 January 2015, Troy Bradley and Leonid Tiukhtyaev landed their Two Eagles balloon on 31 January off the coast of Baja California in Mexico, thus completing the crossing of the Pacific Ocean. They broke the two records of duration (**160h 34 min**) and distance (**10711.6 km**) in the process.

On 28 June 2015, André Borschberg took off from Nagoya, Japan, aboard Solar Impulse. After **117h 52 min** in the air he finally touched down in Hawaii, USA, having flown a distance of **7039.9 km** – all that without using a drop of fuel. This flight was part of Bertrand Piccard and André Borschberg's journey started in Abu Dhabi in March 2015, which resulted in several world records. Taking turns to pilot the single-seat solar aircraft, they travelled about 20,000 km and crossed half of the Pacific Ocean before reaching Hawaii in July.

### WINGSUIT FLYING RECORD

Jackie Harper set the first three female wingsuit world records on 26, 27 and 28 May 2015 while competing in the 1st FAI World Cup of Wingsuit Performance Flying in Netheravon, United Kingdom: longest time (**78.4 sec**), greatest distance (**4.059 km**) and greatest speed (**271.5 km/h**). 2015 was the first year in which Wingsuit records were ratified by FAI.

### OPEN CLASS GLIDERS

- Speed over a triangular course of 100 km

Tijl Schmelzer and his father Bert were the very first to pass the 200 km/h barrier using thermals rather than mountain waves. Flying a Binder EB28 glider from Kiripotib, Namibia, they broke the African record for speed over a triangular course of 100 km by reaching **205.89 km/h** on 6 January 2015.

## SYMPOSIUM ON MEDICAL CHALLENGES IN EXTREME AIR SPORTS AND IN AVIATION

The Symposium on Medical Challenges in Extreme Air Sports and in Aviation took place on 4 and 5 December as a side-event to the FAI World Air Games Dubai 2015. More than 120 aeromedical doctors and experts from around the world were in attendance. They met world-renowned speakers such as Dr. Melchor Antunano of the Civil Aerospace Medical Institute, Dr. Antony Evans of the International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO), and multiple gliding record breaker Dr. Klaus Ohlmann.

Organised by the FAI Medico-Physiological Commission, the Emirates Aerosports Federation and the Dubai medical authorities, the event was meant as a platform for the communication of experience and research in medical aspects of aviation sports, with a special focus on safety.

## ANTI-DOPING

Following the new version of the World Anti-Doping Code by WADA (World Anti-Doping Agency), FAI revised its FAI Anti-Doping Rules. After a thorough and careful review, they were approved by the FAI Executive Board and WADA. Both WADA and FAI documents came into force on 1st January 2015.

The growing number of "Therapeutic Use Exemptions" sent to the FAI Head Office show the increasing awareness of air sports athletes of the role of medicaments on their performance. [www.fai.org/cimp-anti-doping-programme](http://www.fai.org/cimp-anti-doping-programme)

## ENVIRONMENT


The FAI Environmental Commission created a newsletter to bring to the public the most important trends and innovations from the growing field of environmentally conscious pilots and technicians.

The Delegates of the FAI Members gathered in Rotterdam, The Netherlands, to attend the 109th FAI General Conference organised on 25 and 26 September 2015 by the Royal Netherlands Aeronautical Association. The Sessions were preceded by the 2015 FAI Awards Ceremony, where the prestigious FAI and FAI-Breitling Awards were presented to the recipients.

H.E. Yousif Al Hammadi, Director of the FAI World Air Games Dubai 2015, brought the torch of the event to the Conference and updated the Delegates on the preparations for the competition.

For the first time, workshops were held before the Sessions to allow the attendees to learn and discuss about selected topics such as Anti-doping and IT services.



### SPORTS AND BRANDING STRATEGY

The Executive Board presented the "FAI 2020" concept which includes a review and refining of the FAI Brand as well as a strategy to further develop air sports in all aspects.

### PROJECTS

Reports on different projects were made during the Conference. They included:

- **Organiser Agreement**  
The new Organiser Agreement under development will be rolled out in 2016.
- **FAI World Air Games Dubai 2015**  
Everyone's motivation was very high to make sure this competition would be a great success and a milestone event for air sports. It would be a great opportunity for FAI to build on this success to further develop media and public friendly multi-sports competitions.
- **Marketing and Communication**  
FAI is now communicating regularly in several languages to report on competitions and activities, to celebrate aeronautic or astronautic record anniversaries, and to make announcements. Special efforts were made to increase the promotion of selected events, which included audiovisual production and distribution.
- **Regional Management System**  
East & South Asia Regional Vice President Tengku Abdillah from Malaysia reported on the development of air sports in the region.
- **FAI Anti-Doping Programme**  
A new World Anti-Doping Code was implemented on the 1st January 2015 but with no major change for FAI.

- **Membership survey**  
Results of a first round of surveys were shown. More detailed results of the survey will be presented to the Conference in 2016.
- **Multi-sport events**  
Multi-sports events such as The World Games 2017 in Wroclaw, Poland, and the Asian Beach Games will be a perfect playground to showcase air sports.
- **Commissions and OSTIV**  
Each Commission President reported on the activities of their sports and field and highlighted the main challenges they are currently facing, as well as their objectives for the future.

Captain Veerayuth Didyasarini presented the project for the establishment of the Air Sports Federation of Asia (AFA); Sergey Ananov gave a vivid account of his attempt to circumnavigate the globe in a helicopter, which abruptly ended after it crashed into the sea between Canada and Greenland.

### FINANCE

The FAI Executive Director (Finance) reported on the 2014 Financial Statements and the General Conference adopted the Auditor's Report for the year 2014. Later, the Delegates also approved the budget for FAI operations in 2016.

All details on the FAI finances, including the report of the FAI auditors Price Waterhouse Coopers, are set out in the Minutes of the General Conference and available as annexes to the Minutes.

### ELECTIONS

There were no elections in 2015, except for the Statutes Working Group and Active Members Representatives on the FAI Air Sport General Commission CASI (France, Germany, Hong Kong, Switzerland, United Kingdom).


### FUTURE GENERAL CONFERENCES

The Red Bull Air Race World Championship features the world's best race pilots in a pure motor-sport competition that combines speed, precision and skill. The pilots use the fastest, most agile and lightweight racing planes to navigate a predefined, low-level aerial racetrack of air-filled pylons (air gates) with the aim of finishing in the fastest time possible, incurring as few penalties as possible.

The FAI is delighted to have been the partner of such a thrilling and successful series as the Red Bull Air Race since 2005. According to the agreement between both parties, the Federation provides FAI medals especially designed for the Red Bull Air Race; all races are included in the FAI Events Calendar; and the FAI approves the race Rules & Regulations. Furthermore, an FAI Safety Delegate attends all events to supervise safety aspects.

The 2015 season of the Red Bull Air Race World Championship featured eight locations spanning four continents. The series started in Abu Dhabi (United Arab Emirates), followed by stops in Chiba (Japan), Rovinj (Croatia), Budapest (Hungary), Ascot (United Kingdom), Spielberg (Austria), Fort Worth (USA), and ending with the finale in Las Vegas (USA). British pilot Paul Bonhomme won the overall Championship for a third time.

To fulfil its objectives and meet the evolving needs of each air sport and area of activity, the FAI has constantly adjusted its organisational structure. Today, the FAI comprises the following elements:

### GENERAL CONFERENCE

The supreme policy-making body defines the aims of FAI, determines its Statutes and By-Laws and elects the President and the Executive Board. The General Conference convenes once a year. It consists of Delegates appointed by Active and Associate Members in good standing, designated representatives of International Affiliate Members in good standing, FAI elected Officers, Presidents of Honour, Honorary Patrons of FAI, Companions of Honour, and Commission Presidents.

### EXECUTIVE BOARD

The FAI Executive Board is the principal executive body of FAI, responsible for implementing the policies and decisions made by the General Conference and exercising those powers of the General Conference that are delegated to it by that body. The Executive Board, chaired by the FAI President, is jointly responsible to the General Conference for all decisions made and actions taken between General Conferences.

### AIR SPORT COMMISSIONS

The Air Sport Commissions control the activities of the different disciplines governed by the FAI: Aerobatics, Aeromodelling, Amateur-built and Experimental Aircraft, Astronautic Records, Ballooning, General Aviation, Gliding, Hang Gliding and Paragliding, Microlights and Paramotors, Parachuting, Rotorcraft.

### MEMBERS

The Member Nations of FAI are represented by their "National Air Sport Control" (NAC). At the General Conference, voting powers are held by FAI Active Members and by the Air Sport Commissions. With more than 100 Members, the FAI brings together at international level representatives of all air sport disciplines.

The FAI Members are categorised as per Statutes:

- **Active Members**, being those organisations which represent all the disciplines practiced in their respective country.
- **Associate Members**, which represent only one discipline. There can be no more than two associate members in a given country without their forming a national organisation and becoming an Active Member.
- **Temporary Members**, being those national organisations which intend to become an Active or Associate Member of the FAI but are not yet in a position to fulfill all the rights and duties of those members.
- **International Affiliate Members**, other international organisations sharing common goals with the FAI.

### EXPERT SYSTEM

In 2012 the FAI Executive Board started the development of a new FAI Expert System which includes 8 Expert Groups: Airspace, Education, Facilities, IT, Navigation, Regulation, Safety, New Technology.

### Expert Groups

The FAI Expert Groups are persons with expertise in specific areas who are called upon when there is a need for technical expertise. They are appointed by the FAI Executive Board and are on stand-by and assignments are only carried out "on demand".

### Technical Commissions

These Commissions control non-sporting activities such as aviation medicine and environmental matters.

### REGIONAL VICE-PRESIDENTS

FAI Regional Vice Presidents are appointed by the FAI Executive Board to increase the management resources of the FAI in a particular region and provide the Executive Board with a tool for effective regional presence and a mechanism to promote air sports.

### VICE-PRESIDENTS

The FAI Vice Presidents consist of the Vice Presidents representing Active Members and the Presidents of the Air Sport Commissions.

### HEAD OFFICE

The FAI Head Office is managed by the Secretary General, who is responsible for the day-to-day operations of the federation.
