Subject: Request for clarification of the following issues by Chief Judge Anders Berggren.
Details: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Definitions of lines to be used in the landing zone in the Accuracy Landing event according to CR 4.3 2) Clarification to CR 7.5.2. It has been pointed out by the CJ, that rule 7.5.2 does insufficiently describe, that touching a zone with a negative point value during landing first, will exclude to be awarded landing zone points, when touching a landing zone with a positive point value attached during landing afterwards. 3) The CJ pointed out a discrepancy in CR 4.3.3 regarding the “Official Training Period” and the Bulletin-1 and -2 for the Event.

Jury-Decision:

Re 1) The specifications of the lines to be “clearly visible”, to be “designed, to minimize injuries and fast to repair” in conjunction with the statement that the lines are “acceptable to the Chief Judge and the Course Technical Director” and the fact, that the same lines were used and approved already at the IPC FCE in Kolomna in 2010, are sufficient proof for the Jury, that the requirement of an “approximate width” of the lines is met sufficiently.

Re: 2) The Jury agreed to the point made by the CJ to add and to apply the wording proposed by the CP-Committee to CR 7.5.2 for clarification, which is inserted to the text below *in italic*, so that the § 7.5.2. reads

“The competitor is awarded with the point value of the landing zone with the lowest positive value and the point value with the landing zone with the highest negative value, which was touched during landing. **However, if the first touch is in a Landing Zone with a negative point value, no positive value points will be awarded.**”

Re. 3) CR 4.3.3 states, that “the organizer must provide the opportunity for practice jumps for the competitors on all event courses during the OPP”. In the view of the Jury, this opportunity has been provided.

The CR require, that there are 3 days provided for the Official Practice Period. Bulletin-1 and Bulletin-2 have been published with IPC-Bureau approval giving only the dates of August 26 and August 27, 2013 without any further intervention in the meantime. De facto the opportunity for training jumps before these 2 dates has been present. The Jury concludes, that the intent of 4.3.3 has been provided sufficiently.
