IPC Jury Meeting No: # 01

Time and Date: 11.15 hours, August 22nd, 2016

Subject: request of Chief Judge to accept the course markers for G1 in all events, G2, G3, G4 and G5 in carved speed and also G5 in drag-distance, and to declare the competition circumstance not acceptable for any record.

Details:

- 1) The available course markers are of a height of approximately 1,70 m and not approximately 1,50 meters as stated in Annex 6.2. The word "approximately" is not defined in the competition rules. The Chief Judge is of the opinion that 1,70 m exceeds the approximately 1,50 m.
- 2) Since the 1,70 m course markers are higher than stated in the rules, they may have a different and potential supporting effect to record performances. Therefore, a record cannot be achieved in this competition.

Decision:

1) The Jury is of the opinion that 1,70 m is beyond the reasonable interpretation of "approximately 1,50 m". 20 cm more is more than 10%. Therefore, the Jury agrees with the interpretation of the Chief Judge in this part. They also acknowledges the circumstances that the available markers cannot – despite several attempts – be modified to meet the approximately 1,50 m height requirement. This changed condition will affect all competitors during the official training jump and during the competition in the same way, there is no preference for one competitor to the other.

The Jury decides to accept to the available approximate 1,70 m markers for this competition, including the official training jumps.

2) The Jury is of the opinion that 1,70 m is beyond the approximate margin of 1,50 m. This changed condition clearly can have an effect on the performance needed to achieve any record

The Jury decides that during this particular competition no record can be achieved, nor can any record related communication be made on any performance which is better than current CP world or continental records.
