	Background: A significant number of Argus units come in for the functional check-up well overdue of the four year cycle.
	Every 4 years the Argus SIS must have a functional check-up at a local Authorized Service Center. (Argus User Guide: 2.6 Specifications and 3.2 Disclaimer)
	Service Bulletin: All systems that had their last functional check-up carried out over 4 years + 3 months are considered not airworthy and should not be installed in any parachute system.
	All units of which the serial number appears upon the list included as part of the full Argus Service Bulletin, No. SB AMMO130514/1 are NOT AIRWORTHY.
