

Larry Newman Inducted 2011



LARRY NEWMAN Sept. 28, 1947–Dec. 20, 2010

Involved in aviation almost since infancy, Larry was a world champion hang glider, hang glider designer, owner of Electra Flyer Corp. and co-inventor of the ultra-light airplane. Larry Newman had no ballooning experience prior to the Double Eagle II balloon flight, the first across the Atlantic Ocean. As the third crewman, Newman was the radio operator and assisted the veteran pilots in navigation. He also oversaw photo documentation of the flight.

Newman also teamed with Ben Abruzzo, Ron Clark and Rocky Aoki on the crew of Double Eagle V, the first manned balloon to cross the Pacific Ocean.
